



Lætare Sunday – The 4th Sunday in Lent

The term is derived from the opening words of the Latin Mass, "Rejoice (Lætare) Jerusalem" (Isaiah 66:10). The church is called to joyful anticipation of the victory to be won. This joyful theme provides lightening from the penitential emphasis of Lent. Since the thirteenth century, the celebrant of the eucharist has been permitted to wear rose-colored vestments that express the change of tone in the Lenten observance. Our Rose Vestments were a gift from John Raposa and Jon Coates.
